(Shirley Mapes Woodworth Line):

DNA testing apparently shows that Walter does not belong to the Thomas Woodward and Elizabeth Tyson family as many genealogists believed. Although we do not know who was tested, until we hear otherwise, we will assume that the tested individual was in the Walter Woodward lineage and not adopted. Note that Walter's first male child was named "Thomas". Also note that he has a daughter named" Elizabeth". Some genealogists claim Walter married Elizabeth Rogers, dau. of Thomas Rogers of the Mayflower which would be another possible link for the children's names, but at this point, no one knows.
